MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES OF GOVERNING COUNCIL

5. Implement mechanisms for continuous improvement in teaching, research and infrastructure to maintain high educational standards.
6. Allocate resources efficiently to support various departments and initiatives within the institution.
7. Participate in the selection, evaluation and professional development of faculty members.
8. Oversee policies and initiatives that promote the well-being and holistic development of students.
9. Ensure compliance with regulatory requirements and work towards achieving accreditation for the institution.
10. Encourage and support research activities by fostering a conducive environment for faculty and student research projects.

- 7 to 11 – Academicians of excellence

TERM

The term of the members shall be three years.

MEETING AND ITS VENUE

The Governing Council shall meet at least twice a year. All such meetings shall be held within the respective college campus. It shall be the responsibility of the correspondent to ensure that the meetings are held regularly and keeps record.

QUORUM

The quorum for the meeting shall be 50% of the total members of the Governing Council.
